Various Single Lane Closures Expected Along Hutchinson River Parkway in Eastchester, Pelham and Mount Vernon, Westchester County

The New York State Department of Transportation is advising Westchester County motorists to expect various single lane closures along the southbound Hutchinson River Parkway in the villages of Eastchester and Pelham and the city of Mount Vernon, daily beginning Monday, February 22 through Friday, February 29, between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. to facilitate bridge construction work.

The lane closures are necessary to facilitate an ongoing bridge [replacement and rehabilitation project](#) in Lower Westchester.

Motorists are reminded to Move Over a lane, if safely possible, or slow down significantly whenever encountering roadside vehicles displaying red, white, blue, amber or green lights, including maintenance and construction vehicles in work zones.

Motorists are urged to slow down and drive responsibly in work zones. Fines are doubled for speeding in a work zone. Convictions of two or more speeding violations in a work zone could result in the suspension of an individual's driver license.
